Those who meet the criteria below will receive a Participation Patch (first award only) and Year Rocker in recognition of your support. Super H.O.G. Stars will be awarded to those exceptional Chapter members who earn more than 50 points within the calendar year; one Super H.O.G. star is awarded for each additional increment of 25 points during the award period.

Goals are good... goals provide purpose...motivation... and sometimes, attaining goals even affords bragging rights.

So, the Fort Hood H.O.G. Chapter has set a new goal. We'd like to see the chapter log 1,000,000 miles ridden during calendar year 2008. Yup, a million miles, via group effort, of course.

How can you help? First, contact any chapter officer and provide your current mileage reading to enroll. At the end of the year, we need your final mileage reading. Miles will be totaled to determine how far we rode. No rocket science involved. Note, however, this is separate from the National H.O.G. Mileage Program. But if you're not enrolled in that, why not do both at once!

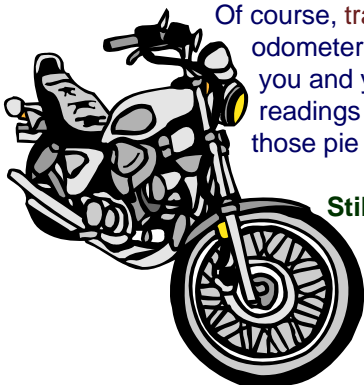
And no excuses!

"But I don't attend many (or any!) chapter rides, although I am a chapter member." That's okay! The Million Mile Club goal is open to ANY current member of the Fort Hood H.O.G. Chapter. Miles reported include any and all riding you do – to and from work, border to border runs, and everything in between – not just those miles accrued on chapter rides. So your mileage counts, even if you don't have an opportunity to get out and ride with the chapter.

"I don't ride very much so my contribution seems like a waste." That's okay, too. Even if you just ride occasionally, each mile you report adds up and is one less mile someone else has to ride to reach the overall goal.

"I'm a backseat rider..." YOU count, too! That's right, people thought the carpool lane was the only benefit in taking along a passenger. Now, the Million Mile Club goal provides yet another incentive. Mileage counts for you AND your passenger if they are a Chapter member enrolled in the Million Mile Club. So stop going solo and start racking up double miles!

Of course, **tracking progress** can provide additional motivation... so we'd like for you to email your odometer readings by the 20th of each month so we can include something in the newsletter to let you and your fellow riders know how well we're doing throughout the year. Providing interim readings isn't mandatory, but who doesn't like colorful charts? So provide your input so we can get those pie charts and bar graphs brightly colored in!



Still need more incentive? That was expected. We know now we are a group that is often best motivated by the proverbial dangling carrot. Sign up for the Million Mile Club and log at least 1,500 miles during the goal year. When the Chapter reaches its goal, you'll receive a little something to commemorate our achievement and your contribution. As an added bonus, participate in the Million Mile Club and complete at least 25% of scheduled chapter rides for consideration in the "most miles ridden" race.
